## Knock down large areas of gorse with Garlon® 600 Herbicide

Long-term control of gorse will require a variety of methods. Depending on the situation, this is best achieved by bulldozer or a high volume spray application of Garlon 600 or a combination of both options.

On land that is suitable for sowing down to pasture, mechanical clearing is an ideal method of control. Bulldozers with rippers or medium to heavy tractors with dozer blades and rippers attached can be used.

Some work has also been done to incorporate the use of heavy slashers that apply herbicide at the same time.

In dense gorse stands, satisfactory spray coverage is not likely to be achieved beyond a range of 4–5 m. If the stand is larger, access paths should be cleared to allow complete coverage.



## Follow up with Grazon® Extra Herbicide

Regrowth of well established gorse bushes after mechanical control is not suitable for herbicide treatment until it is up to 1 m high. When gorse is 1 to 1.5 m tall use Grazon Extra at 250 mL/100 L of water.
