

Management strategies

How to treat

Treating isolated patches and limited infestations

Use Grazon Extra at 500 mL/100 L of water, applied as an overall spray. Thorough coverage of the plant is essential.



For best results

For optimum results, add Pulse® Penetrant at 200 mL/100 L of spray. Thoroughly wet foliage, stems and soil around the base of the plants.

Where slashing has resulted in regrowth, allow at least one year's regrowth or until regrowth has reached 1 m tall before treatment.

Treatment tips

Applied as a foliar spray, Grazon Extra is sufficiently rainfast that light rain within one hour of application is unlikely to adversely affect results. Thoroughly wet foliage, stems and soil around the base of plants.

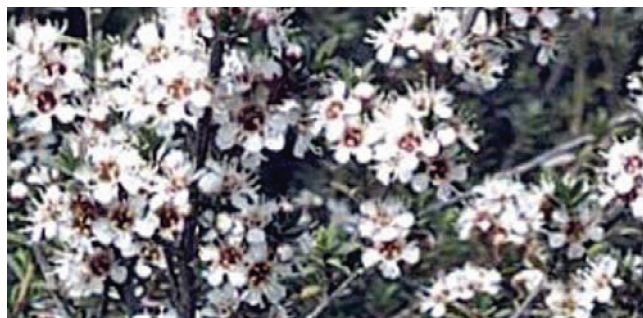

Manuka (*Leptospermum scoparium*)

Description

Manuka is a prolific scrub-type tree and is often one of the first native species to regenerate on cleared land. It is typically a shrub growing to 2–5 m tall, but can grow into a moderately sized tree, up to 15 m in height. It is evergreen, with dense branching and small leaves 7–20 mm long and 2–6 mm broad, with a short spine tip. The flowers are white, occasionally pink, 8–15 mm (rarely up to 25 mm) diameter, with five petals and seen from late spring to early summer.



Timing

Optimum control of manuka with herbicides occurs during the flowering growth stage (late spring – early summer).
